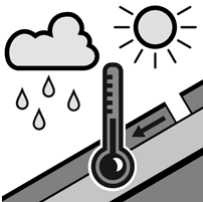


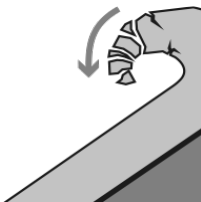

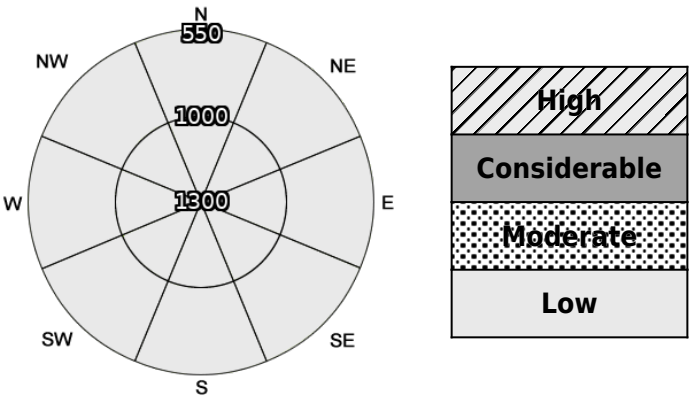

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate in the milder conditions and remain generally stable in all areas. Some surface instabilities may occur on the steepest slopes and cornices that overhang many West to Northerly aspects will be prone to collapse. At lower elevations although soft the snowpack will be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with strong Westerly winds backing to the South during the afternoon. Remaining mild for most of the period, turning cooler through the afternoon with freezing levels dipping below the summits.
