

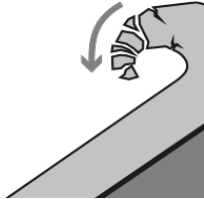

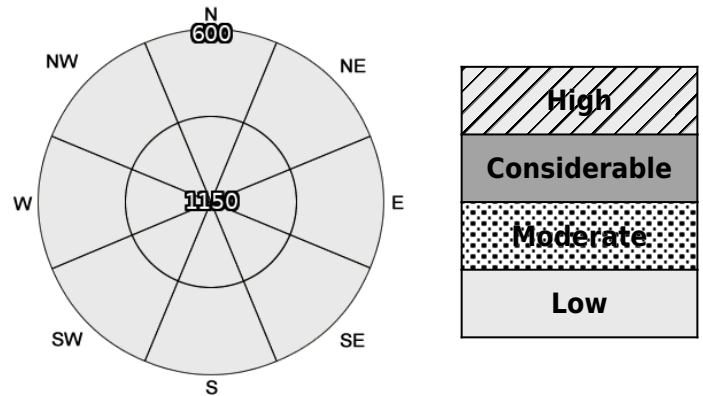
Wet Snow

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to moisten and soften overnight. Localised wet snow instabilities will be found on very steep slopes, with West to North-West aspects above 800 metres most affected. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Strong Westerly winds slowly backing Southerly during the period. Rain at all levels initially then becoming mainly dry from early morning. Further showers falling as snow only on the highest summits in the afternoon. Freezing level starting well above the summits with summit temperatures dropping to around zero in the afternoon.

**Comments**

Cooler conditions arriving on Friday with scattered snow showers and easing winds.
