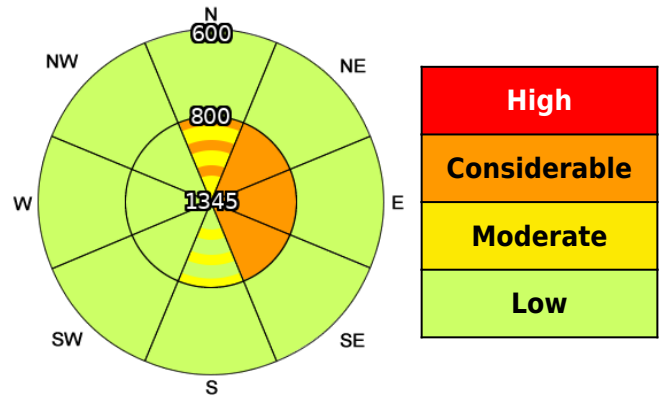
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wet snow surface instabilities will be present on steep slopes overnight and during Friday morning. As the freezing level drops, fresh areas of unstable windslab will form in areas sheltered from the Westerly winds. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a period of heavy rain overnight at all levels followed by snow showers above 800 metres by Friday afternoon. Winds will be strong from the South-East overnight and becoming moderate Westerly during the day.
