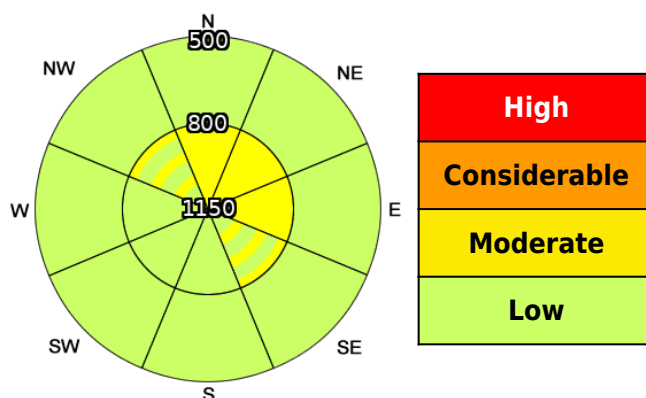


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 23/03/2018****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The old snowpack will consolidate in the colder conditions through the day. Areas of fresh windslab will be deposited on mainly North to East aspects above 800 metres. These are not expected to be particularly extensive. Below this level the snowpack will continue to slowly consolidate. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

After a mild night the freezing level will drop to around 800 metres during the morning. Overnight rain will turn to snow above about 600 metres during the morning before clearing in the afternoon. Southerly winds will veer to the West.
