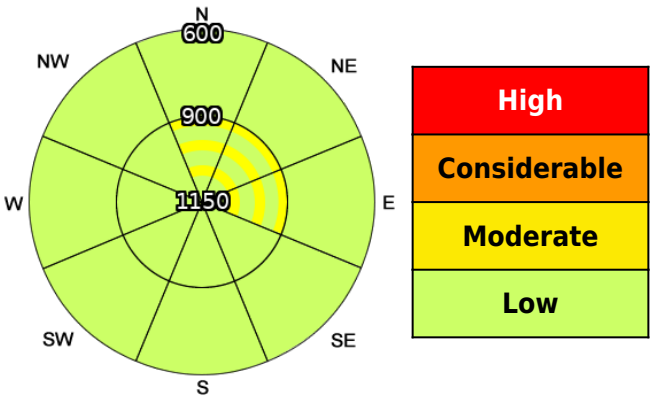
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will further consolidate in the cooler conditions. Some fresh deposits of windslab will be deposited on North to East aspects above 900 metres through the day. However, these are expected to be shallow, localised and generally avoidable. The tops of slopes and gullies will be most affected. Elsewhere stability will be generally good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be around 700 metres. It will be dry overnight with a few snow showers during the day. Winds will be from the South-West.
