


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 26/03/2018

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised windslab which remains on North to North-East aspects above 1000 metres will continue to consolidate. Elsewhere the old snowpack will be firm well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers will clear during the night. Moderate West-North-Westerly winds will ease during the afternoon and back to the South-South-West. The 700 metre freezing level will steadily rise to 1000 metres by the end of the day.

#### Comments

The old snowpack is very firm with serious run-outs.
