

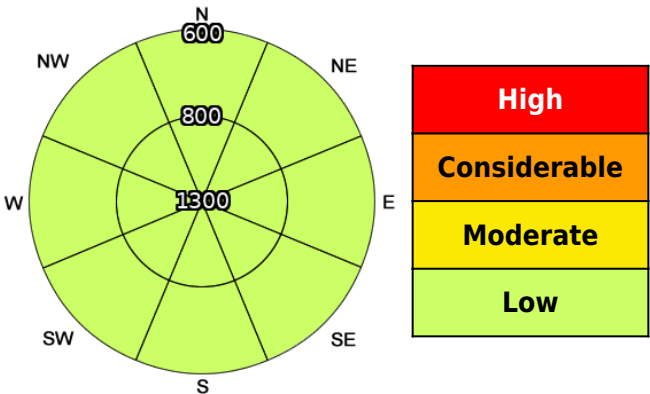

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 28/03/2018

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will re-freeze in the cooler conditions becoming stable, firm and icy in all locations. Some new accumulations of thin snow will form on North to Easterly aspects above 800 metres but amounts are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

West-South-Westerly winds, strong overnight will be light by daybreak veering North-Westerly by the afternoon. Freezing level around 600 metres. Only very light precipitation is expected falling as snow above 400m.

Comments

a slowly diminishing snowpack below 900 metres but will refreeze.
