Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some fresh moderately bonded windslab will develop on steep, mainly North-East through East to South Easterly aspects above 850metres. In most other locations the existing cover above 700 metres will be well consolidated, re-frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight snow showers above 700m, these will lower and become more scattered down to 500 metres during the day. Moderate West-South-West will become light and Westerly, then West-North-West by the end of day.

Comments

Good cover remains above 800 metres, nothing below 600 metres.
