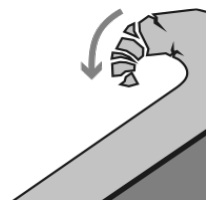
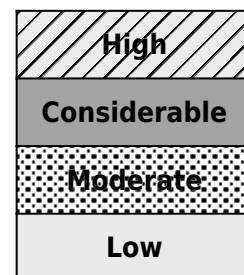
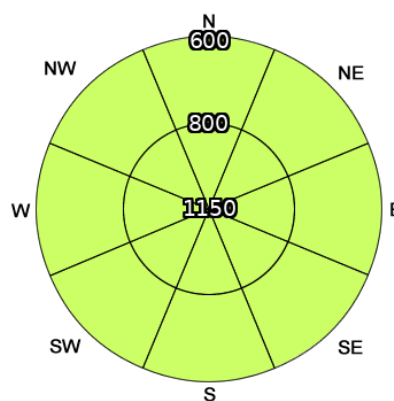

The snowpack will mainly refreeze becoming firm and well bonded on all aspects. Any new accumulations are expected to be light and will not have any effect on stability. Cornices will still require care. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will drop to around 800 metres with potential for a light snow shower later in the afternoon. Overnight strong Westerly winds will veer to the North-West and ease during the day.
