

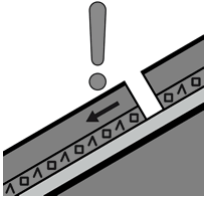

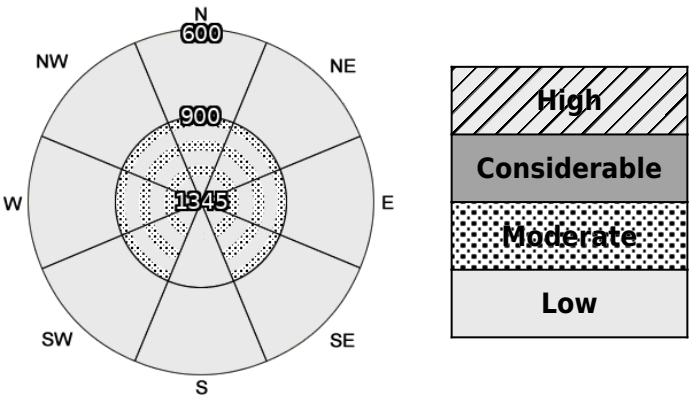
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of fresh windslab will be present mainly on North, North-East and East aspects above 900m although these will generally be restricted to steep gully exist scarp slopes and crag aprons. Elsewhere, the thin fresh snow cover will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a dry day with the freezing level around 400m. North-Easterly winds will decrease through out the period.
