

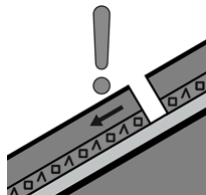

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 31/03/2018

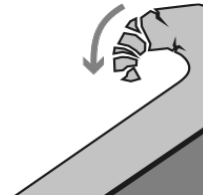
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



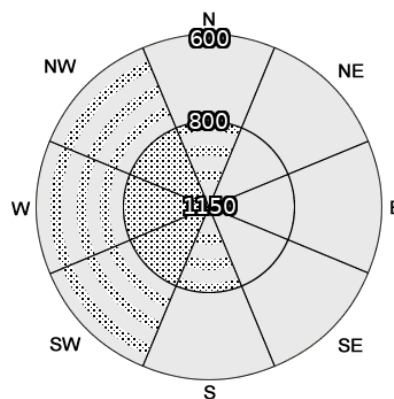
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderate to poorly bonded accumulations will be present particularly around corrie rims and in gully exits on South-West to North-West aspects above 900 metres. Areas of moderately bonded snow will also be found in wind sheltered locations on both North and South aspects and in steep lee locations at lower levels. Elsewhere the snow will be firm and often icy. Cornice collapse remains a significant hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be new light snowfall down to low levels through until lunchtime. Winds East-North-East overnight becoming Easterly during the day and strong throughout.
