

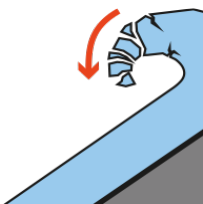

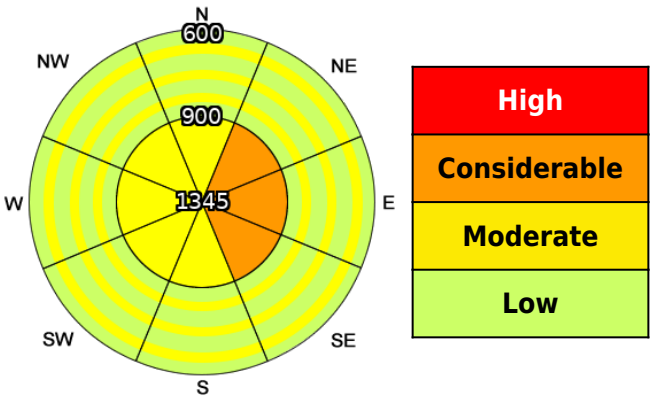

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will thaw in the milder damp conditions. Wet snow instabilities will exist in the deposits of windslab as they become wet. Most affected will be steep North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will slowly rise through the period to be above summit level by late afternoon. Light snow will turn to rain on all but the highest tops. Strong winds will be from the South-East.
