



**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The wet and thawing snowpack will generally be well consolidated with good stability. The old snowpack will remain firm with some surface softening. Pockets of soft snow will persist at higher elevations on most aspects. Also, some slopes, on any aspects, will be threatened by unstable cornices prone to collapse. Glide cracks will become more apparent. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Remaining mild and cloudy with outbreaks of drizzly rain and some sleety snow possible on the highest summits. Light and variable winds overnight will become more Westerly through the afternoon and the freezing level will remain above the summits.

**Comments**

Good snow cover remains above 700 metres and becoming very patchy at lower elevations. Remaining mild.
