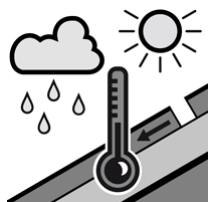


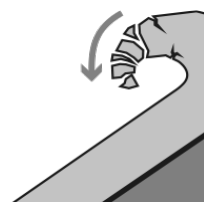

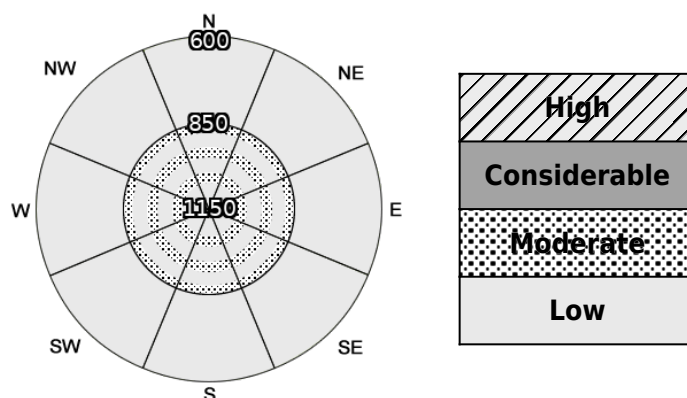
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw but consolidate at all levels. On most aspects above 850 metres greatest hazard will be from cornice collapse triggering large wet snow avalanches below. At lower levels snow will be soft but stable with ground breaking through, particularly on ridges. Collapsing icefalls and falling snow from crags will be a significant hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain above the summits with rain showers overnight. Winds will mostly be light to moderate from the North-West to West.

Comments

Rainfall overnight will further weaken large cornices.
