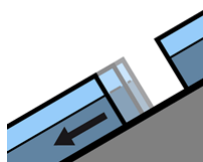

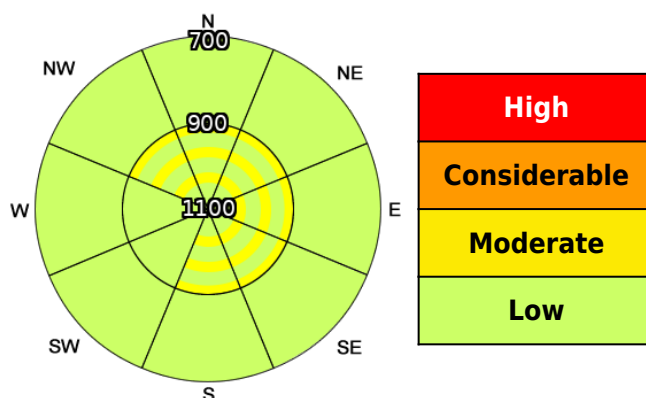

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Only a trace of new snow expected otherwise little change. The slow thaw continues. Residual wet snow instability will persist in very steep locations above 950m on mainly North-West through North to South East aspects. Many of these aspects will also continue to be exposed to the threat of high additional loading from collapsing cornices. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

A little overnight rain and summit snow then dry. Colder for a time overnight then progressively milder during the day. Strengthening South Easterly later Easterly winds.

Comments

Large cornices remaining a feature over many lee slopes.
