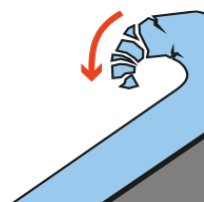
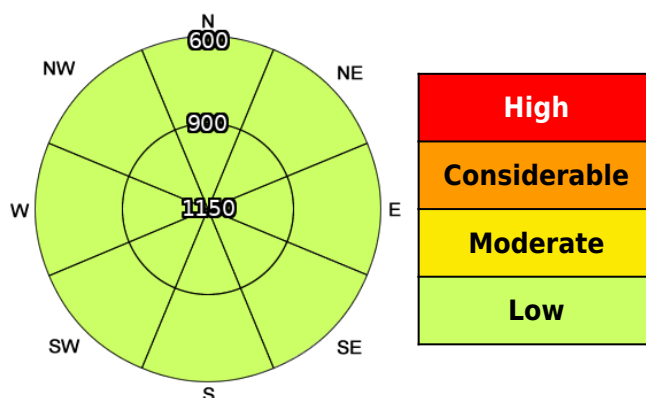


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 11/04/2018****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Any new snow will be short lived as the freezing levels rise. The snowpack will be soft but will be mostly stable with isolated surface instabilities restricted to very steep terrain above 900 metres. Cornice collapse will remain a significant hazard as will falling rock and ice. Snowcover will continue to diminish, particularly at lower levels. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

An overnight dusting of snow on the highest summits, dry thereafter. Gale force winds from the East then East-South-East for most of the day.
