

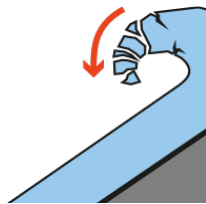

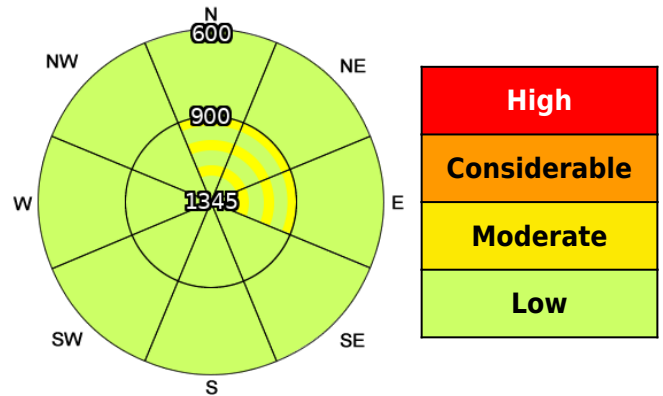
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate. Localised wet snow instabilities will be present, mainly on steep North to East aspects above 900 metres, and on slopes exposed to solar radiation. Many large cornices remain and will be prone to spontaneous collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After some light rain, or sleet at higher levels, this evening the period will be dry. Winds will be moderate to strong mainly East-South-Easterly. The freezing level will initially be around the higher summits overnight, then rising above all summits.
