The snowpack will be soft but generally well bonded. Isolated surface instabilities will be restricted to very steep terrain above 900 metres. Cornice collapse will remain a significant hazard as will falling rock and ice. Snow cover will still be fairly extensive above 900 metres but patchy below this level. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Another mild and cloudy day is forecast. Winds will be strong from the East.
