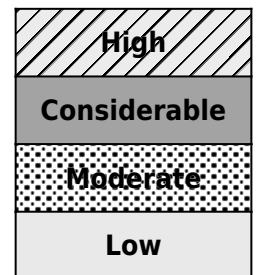
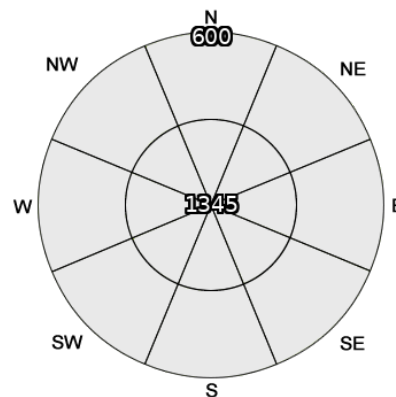
Wet Snow



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and stability will generally be good. Wet snow surface instabilities will be present on some steep slopes. Remaining cornices, mainly present above steep North to East aspects, will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be mainly dry with strong East-South-East winds. The freezing level will be above the summits.

Comments

The continuing warm conditions bring other hazards including:

- ice and rock fall
- cornice collapse
- weak snow bridges
- glide cracks
