Little change expected. The snow will continue to thaw in all locations but it will remain stable throughout. Isolated surface instabilities will be restricted to very steep terrain above 900 metres mainly on North to East aspects. Snow cover will still be fairly extensive above 900 metres but patchy below this level. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A cloudy day with some rain at all levels around dawn but dry thereafter. Winds will initially be strong from the East-North-East but easing slightly and becoming Easterly in the afternoon.
