

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 14/04/2018


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and diminish in extent, especially at lower levels. Consolidation of the snowpack will continue and stability will be mostly good, however surface instabilities will be likely on steep slopes later in the day due to solar warming. The threat from cornice collapse will remain, especially on steep Easterly and West to North aspects. Rockfall from cliffs will also present a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain well above the summits. Mostly dry throughout the forecast period with light to moderate South-Westerly winds.
