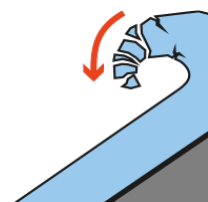


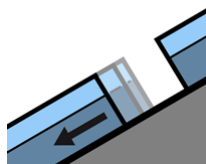

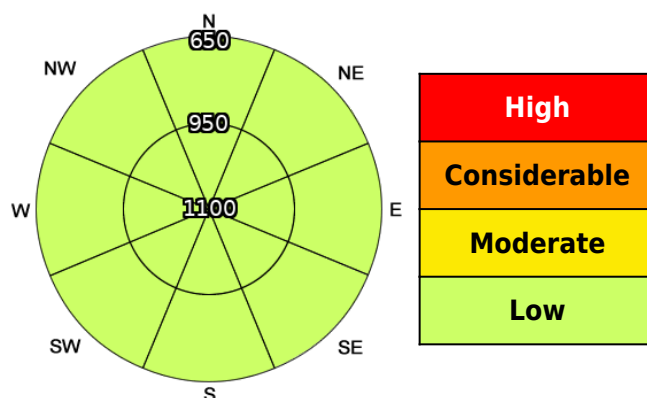

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack although moist will be generally well stabilised in most locations. Some persistent full depth avalanche potential on steeply inclined benches and gullies below 1000 metres on North through East to South-East facing crags. All large cornices remain suspect and liable to collapse in the thaw. Falling ice from crags also a developing issue. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Mild and dry throughout.

Comments

Full depth avalanches are outside the scope of the forecasting and hazard scale. Avalanche release is unpredictable, avalanche activity may occur when the first cracks appear, several days or weeks later, or not release at all.
