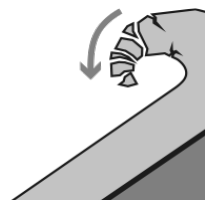

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 14/04/2018

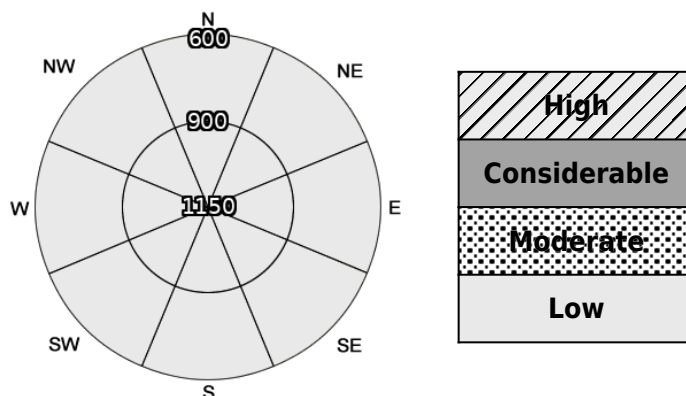
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow will continue to thaw at all levels but remain stable throughout. Surface instabilities will be restricted to isolated areas on steep terrain and also where slopes are subject to solar warming. Snow cover will still be fairly extensive above 900 metres but patchy below this level. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing mild. A cloudy but dry day with cloud possibly clearing in the afternoon. Winds will be light to moderate, mainly from the South-West to the South-South-West.

Comments

Cloudy today with very poor visibility. Likely to be cloudy Saturday morning but hopefully cloud will clear in the afternoon. Remaining mild.
