

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 15/04/2018


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and diminish in extent, especially at lower levels. Consolidation of the snowpack will continue and stability will be mostly good, however surface instabilities will be likely on steep slopes especially later in the day. The threat from cornice collapse will remain, especially on steep Easterly and West to North aspects. Rockfall from cliffs will also present a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and clear overnight with mist and hill fog developing through the day. Moderate Southerly backing South-Easterly winds will increase to strong through the morning. The freezing level will remain above the summits.
