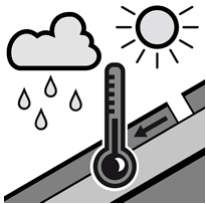


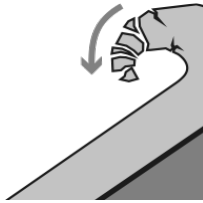

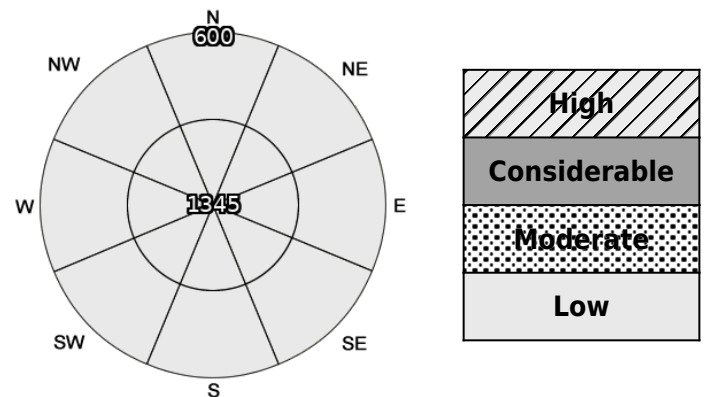
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate, and will be generally stable. Some wet snow surface instabilities will be present on steep slopes. Many large cornices remain, mainly above North to East aspects, and will be prone to spontaneous collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate East-South-East winds slowly increasing to become strong. Mainly dry with some drizzle in the afternoon. Freezing level above the summits.

Comments

Ice and rock fall remain hazards.
