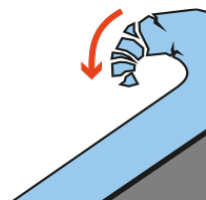
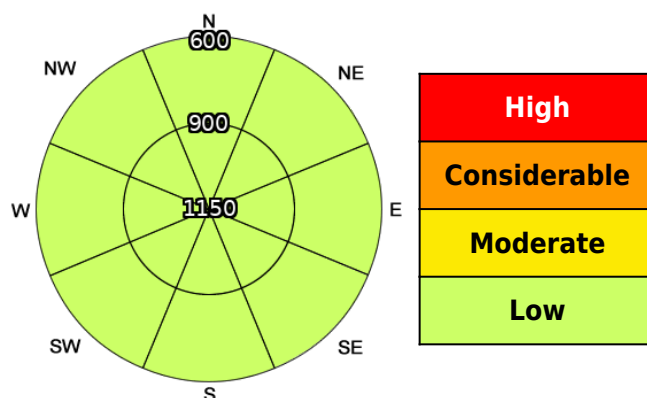


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 15/04/2018****Avalanche Problems****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snow will continue to thaw and moisten at all levels but will remain stable throughout. Surface instabilities will be restricted to isolated areas on steep terrain. Snow cover will still be fairly extensive above 900 metres but patchy below this level. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Remaining mild and becoming cloudy with some drizzle later in the day. Winds will strengthen from the South-East becoming strong in the afternoon.

Comments

This is the last report for 2017/18 Season. A general report will be issued on the main SAIS site for at least the next week and will be tailored for weather/conditions. Any significant avalanche activity can still be reported via the main website.
