

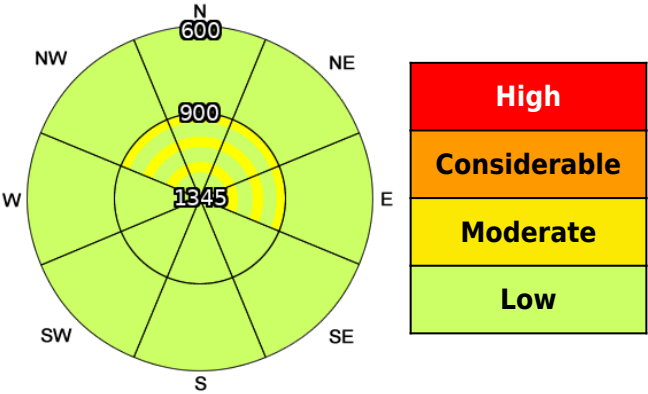
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 17/12/2018

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of moderately bonded windslab will remain in sheltered locations, particularly at the tops of gullies. Most affected will be North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Stability will decrease slightly through the afternoon and into the evening as the freezing level rises. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be relatively settled overnight and through the morning with a freezing level of around 900 metres. During the afternoon South-South-Easterly winds will increase to severe gale force and the freezing level will rise above the summits.

Stormy conditions expected on Monday night and into Tuesday.
