

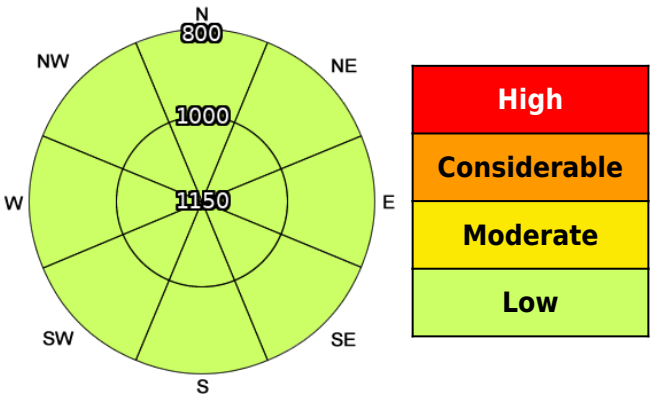

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 19/12/2018

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack will consolidate as the freezing level lowers, any new snow amounts are not expected to be significant, however new deposits will settle mostly on North-West to North-East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A South to South-Westerly airstream with slowly falling freezing levels will affect the area. Whilst mainly dry in the morning, a few light showers are possible in the afternoon, initially as snow above 1100 metres falling to around 800 metres by the end of the forecast period. Winds will mainly be fresh to strong from a Southerly direction.
