

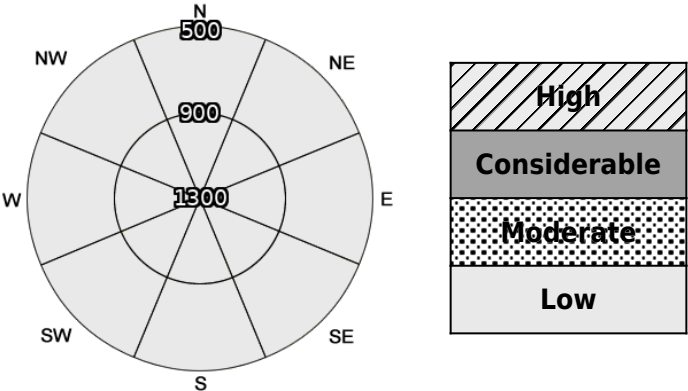

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Small isolated pockets of new wind slab will develop on North to North-North-East aspects above 950 metres. These small pockets will be mostly well bonded and easy to avoid. The deeper snowpack that exists elsewhere above 950 metres will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a few snow showers above 800 metres with moderate South to South-South-West winds. The freezing level will be about 1000 metres.

Comments

Reasonable travel day after the extreme conditions of Deirdre. Cornices somewhat eroded.
