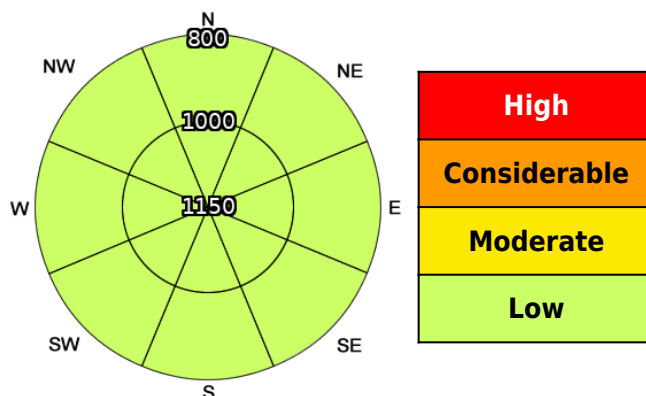

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Windslab will start to form in sheltered areas, especially gully tops, mostly on North-West to North-East aspects above 950 metres. New snow amounts and accumulations are not expected to be substantial. The old snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight, light snow showers mostly above 900 metres these will continue throughout the forecast period mixed in with some rain. South-Easterly winds will be strong overnight then easing by morning then increasing again. The freezing level will fluctuate but lowering to 900 metres by the afternoon.

**Comments**

New snow arriving but with a mixture of rain at times.
