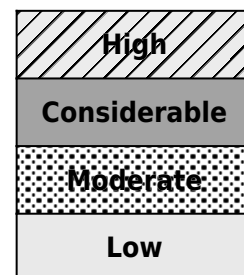
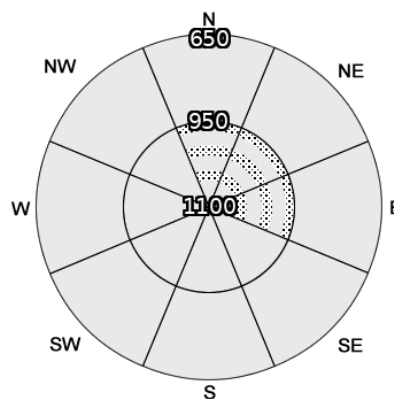
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack is limited in extent and confined to coire rims, gully tops and isolated patches. A little new soft windslab is possible on very steep North West through North to North East aspects above 950m. Accumulations will be shallow, moderately bonded, not extensive and generally easy to avoid. Elsewhere the limited snowpack will be firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A few light overnight snow showers then dry until dawn. More organised snow showers from mid morning for a few hours. Light to moderate generally Southerly winds.

Comments

Freezing level approximately 900m. Limited snowpack. Gullies are very narrow and incomplete.
