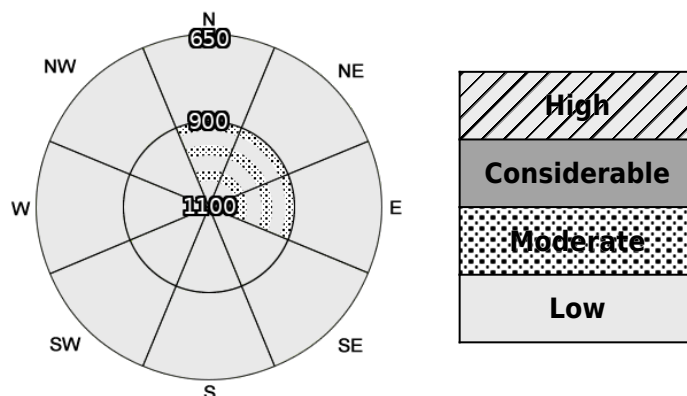
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Additional small quantities of soft and moderately bonded windslab will develop on steepest, mainly North to East facing gully tops above 900 metres, just below coire rims. Elsewhere the very limited snowpack will be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Further showers over the period will fall as snow above 800 metres. The moderate winds, initially South-Westerly will veer and become West-South-Westerly overnight. Freezing level will be around 900 metres throughout.

Comments

The Creag Meagaidh range sometimes gets caught between East and West weather systems; the further East tomorrow seeing only a few showers, with a reasonably dry day in store. Keep a local weather eye out!
