

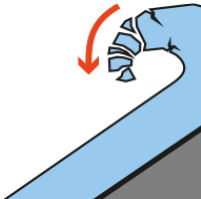

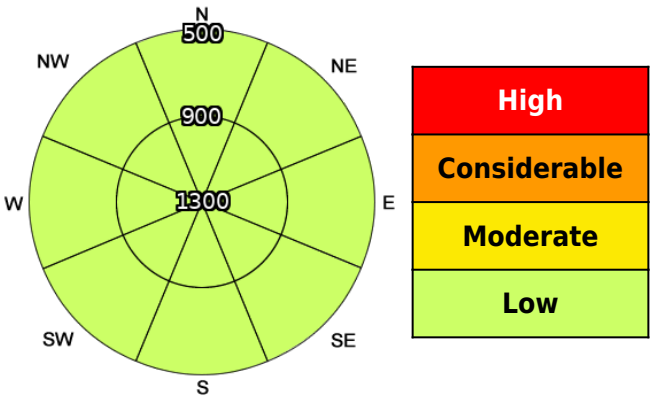

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general the snowpack will remain firm well bonded and stable on all aspects. Greatest accumulations are on North-West to Northerly aspects above 900 metres. Some shallow accumulations of windslab will be present in wind sheltered places mostly above 1000 metres on North-West through North to East aspects, but these deposits will be generally well consolidated. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Mostly dry with some light snow showers during the early morning and late afternoon on moderate South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will be around 1000 metres throughout the forecast period.

Comments

Snowpack remaining mostly firm and icy. Serious run outs into rocks for any trips and falls on steep slopes.
