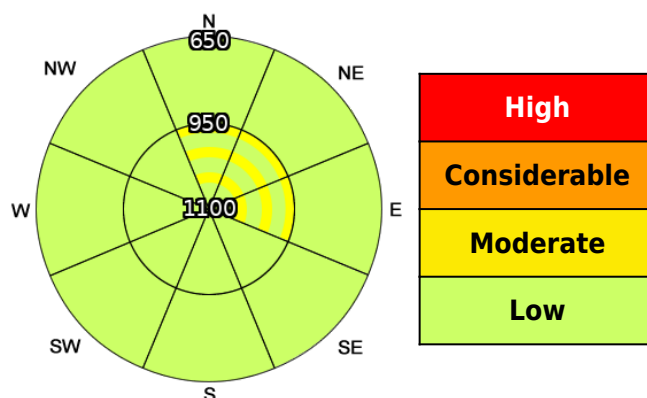
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instability will be limited to localised accumulations of windslab high on coire rims and gully exits. Most affected aspects will be steep North to East aspects above 950 metres. The remainder of the sparse, patchy snowpack will remain frozen and well stabilised. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers will continue overnight then die out in the early hours. Becoming progressively colder. Moderate to strong West-South-West winds easing to very light and variable.

Comments

Looks like remaining dry from Sunday right through the 25th and much milder on Christmas Day, too.
