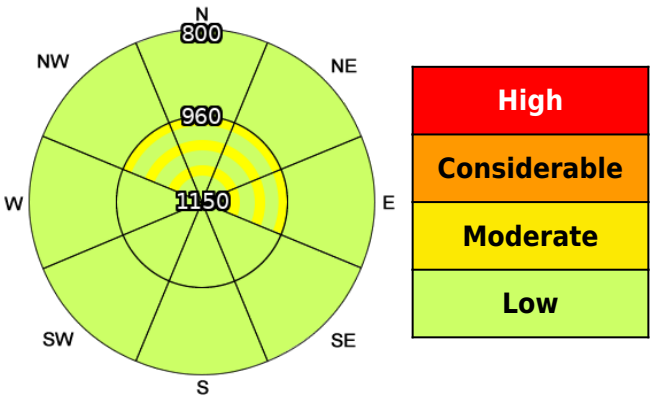
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderately bonded soft windslab will continue to form particularly on steep North-West through North to East aspects mostly above 960 metres with the tops of gullies particularly affected. Windslab accumulations will generally be shallow and not that extensive. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, light snow showers mainly above 900 metres with strong West-North-West winds. During the day, dry cooler conditions the winds will ease and veer to become Northerly. The freezing level will be around 1000 metres.

Comments

The next couple of days should be mainly dry, becoming colder this will lead to some consolidation of the moist snowpack particularly at lower elevations.
