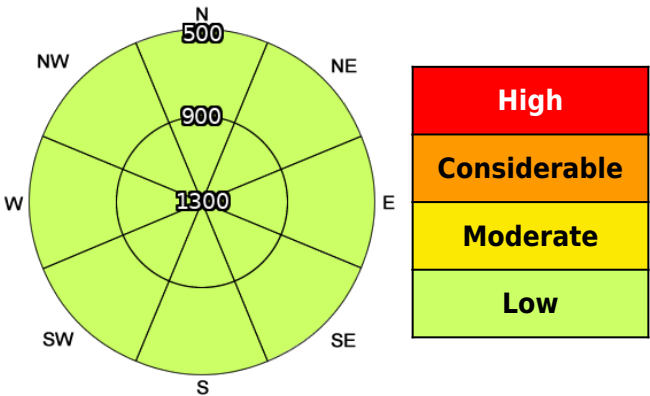
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general the snowpack will remain firm well bonded and stable on all aspects. Greatest accumulations are on North-West to Northerly aspects above 900 metres. Some shallow accumulations of windslab will be present in wind sheltered places mostly above 1000 metres on Northerly to Easterly aspects, but these deposits will be generally well consolidated. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers are expected to clear overnight. Moderate West-South-Westerly winds will ease to light and veer to the North. The freezing level will fall to around 900 metres.

Comments

Snowpack remaining mostly firm and icy. Serious run outs into rocks for any trips and falls on steep slopes.
