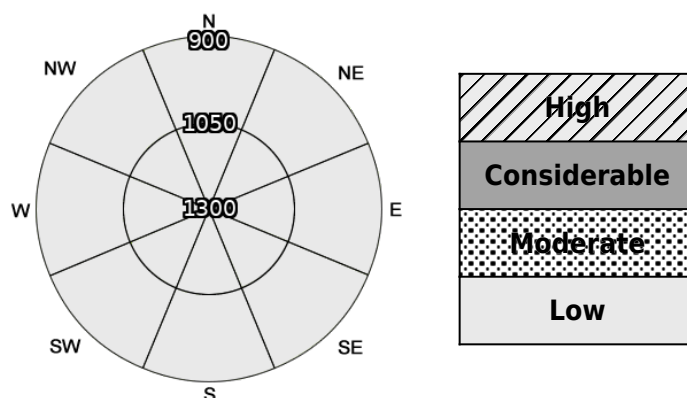
Avalanche Problems



New Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Greatest snow accumulations lie on West to Northerly aspects above 900 metres. The older snowpack will continue to settle with the recent accumulations bonding reasonably well to the old surface. Some surface instabilities will be possible in the recent snow deposits on steep sunny slopes due to late afternoon warming above 1050 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Mostly dry conditions are forecast with light winds. Generally it will remain below freezing on the tops.
