

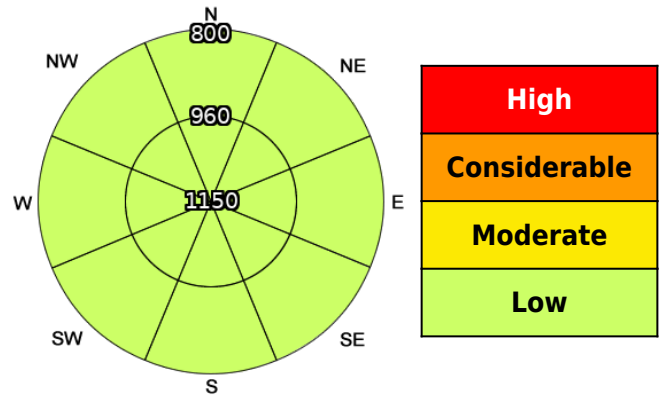

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 24/12/2018

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable on all aspects. Greatest snow accumulations will be on North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Localised, shallow accumulations of windslab will be present in some sheltered locations mostly above 960 metres on North to Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining dry through the forecast period with the freezing level at around 800 metres rising later in the afternoon. The winds will be light Northerly veering to become South-Westerly by dawn.

Comments

Weather outlook: A weak warm front spreading patchy rain or drizzle at all levels for Christmas day.
