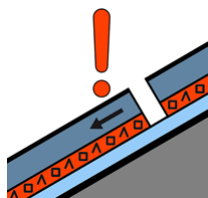

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 24/12/2018

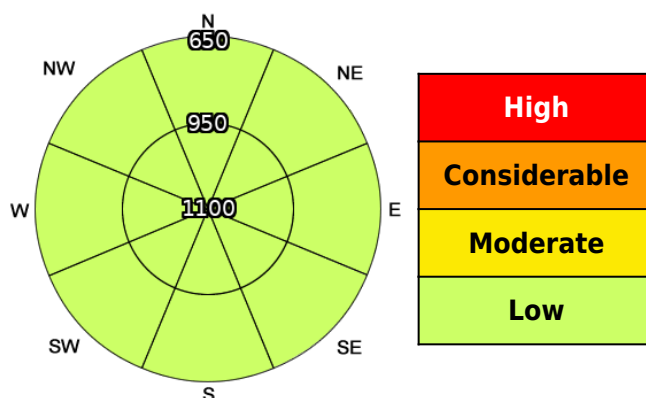
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some early consolidation expected in all recent thin windslab. Instability will be limited to localised accumulations of windslab high on coire rims and gully exits mainly on North to East aspects above 950m. Elsewhere the sparse, patchy snowpack will remain frozen and well stabilised. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Light variable winds becoming moderate South Westerly by the end of the day. Dry and cool throughout.

Thin covering of fresh snow above 900m on Sunday.
