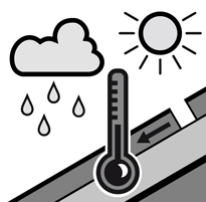
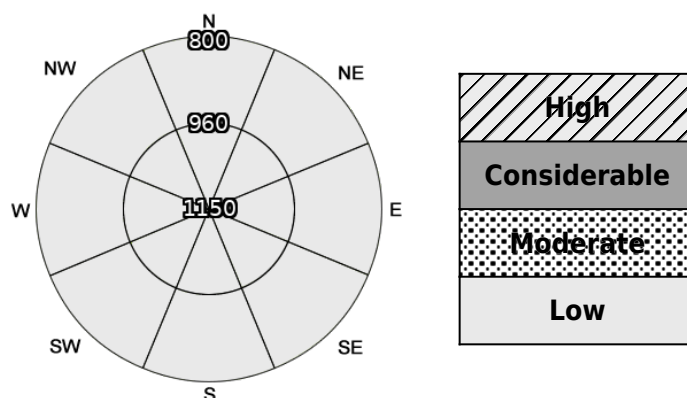


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 25/12/2018****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable on all aspects. However, as milder conditions affect the area the snowpack will start to soften and become moist but stability will remain generally good. Greatest snow accumulations will be present on North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 900 metres and will remain generally well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight, it will be cold and dry with moderate Southerly winds. During the day it will remain dry, the freezing level will slowly rise above the summits. Winds will increase in strength becoming strong Southerly at summit levels.
