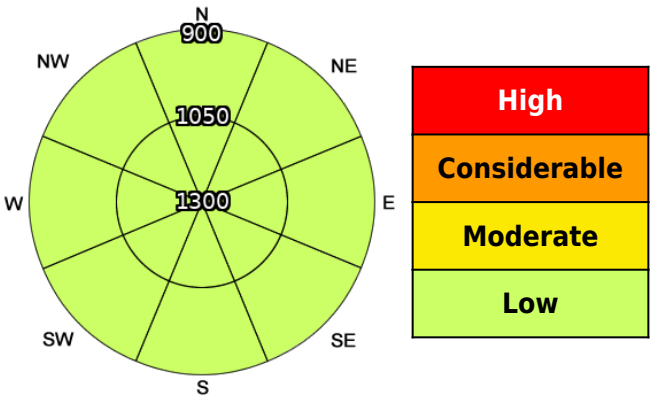
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow cover will diminish. The remaining snowpack although soft will generally be well bonded and stable throughout. Greatest accumulations will be present on West to Northerly aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Temperatures at summit levels gradually rising to plus 4 degrees centigrade by the afternoon. A dry sunny day at first, clouding over through the day with light to moderate strength South-Westerly winds. No precipitation expected.

Comments

Freezing level well above the summits Wednesday but getting colder again Thursday. Have a Happy Christmas day and well see you working off the turkey in the hills in the following days.
