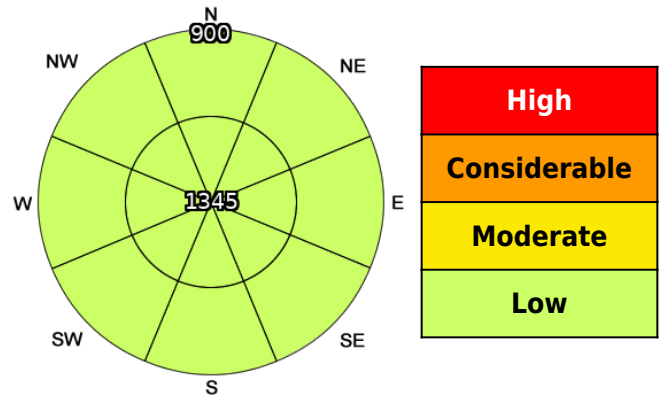
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist, consolidating snowpack will be generally stable. Snow cover is limited with most remaining snow in gullies, hollows and around corrie rims on North to East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Precipitation overnight will fall as snow above around 1000 metres initially but will soon turn to rain at all levels as the freezing level rises well above the summits. The day will then be mainly dry with the freezing level around summit height. Moderate Southerly winds will veer South-Westerly and become strong overnight, then ease and veer Westerly during the day.

Comments

Rock and ice fall remain hazards in the mild conditions.
