

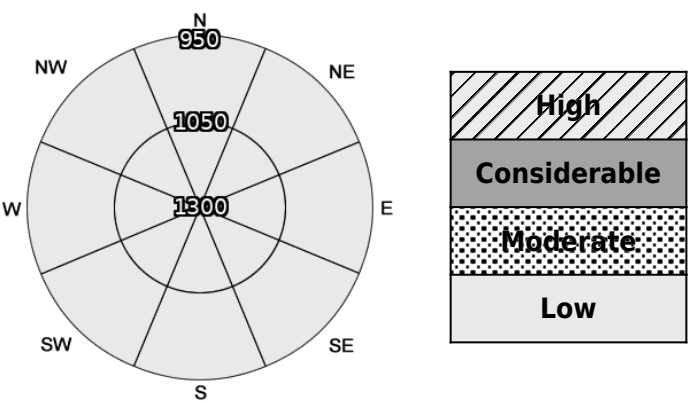

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 30/12/2018

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited moist snowpack will continue to diminish and consolidate in all areas and be generally stable. Greatest depth will remain on North-West to Northerly aspects above 1000 metres. Many other areas will be bare of snow. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light rain overnight, this will clear to leave a dry day with hill fog. Moderate West-South-West winds will increase to strong through the day and veer to the West. Initially freezing around summit levels then rising to well above the tops through the night.

Comments

Rock and ice fall from the buttresses will continue to be a significant hazard during the thaw conditions, easier gully lines becoming broken.
