

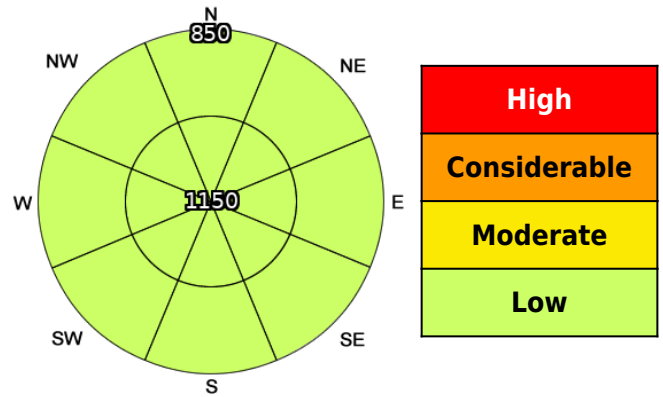
**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 01/01/2019**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected in the sparse snowpack although it will firm up as temperatures lower it will remain stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Gale force Westerly winds gradually easing to become North-Westerly and light by mid-afternoon tomorrow. The persistent rain dying out by late evening and remaining dry during the day. The freezing will gradually drop to around 600 metres by dawn and lower gradually during the day to around 400 metres.

**Comments**

Becoming colder and more settled in the next few days but little snow forecast.
