

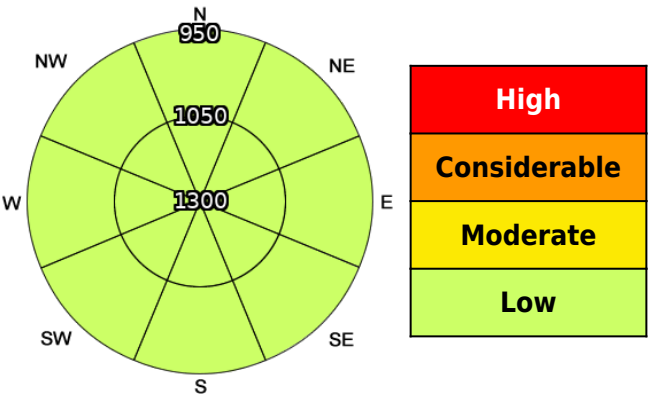

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 03/01/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. The remaining snowpack will be firm, icy and stable. Greatest amounts are mostly above 1000 metres on North-West to Northerly aspects. Many areas remain bare of snow. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold on the tops, with a freezing level around 500 metres throughout the day, but remaining very cold in shaded glens and coires. No precipitation is expected. Winds will be light to moderate strength West-South-Westerly.

Comments

Remaining cold on the tops, sunny at times. Old snowpack will be bullet hard and icy, with serious consequences for any trips and slides from steep snow slopes onto boulders below.
