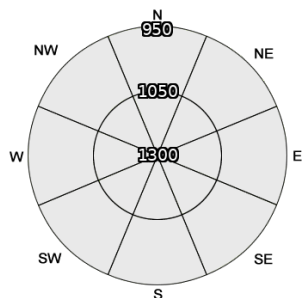


Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Thu 03/01/2019 TO 18:00HRS Fri 04/01/2019



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

A dry day is expected. Winds will be moderate strength West-South-Westerly. Freezing around summit levels.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. The remaining snowpack will be firm, icy and stable. Greatest amounts are mostly above 1000 metres on North-West to Northerly aspects. Many areas remain bare of snow. The avalanche hazard will be Low

Observed Avalanche Hazard - Thu 03/01/2019

Observed Weather Influences

Clear, cold and sunny at first then cloudy on the tops with a light Northerly breeze. Calm in the corries. A dry day

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Little change. A dusting of fine snow is present on all aspects above 800 metres. Areas of old, firm, icy and stable snow remain on mainly North-West to Northerly aspects above 1000 metres. Elsewhere the ground is mostly bare of snow or has a fine dusting. The avalanche hazard is Low

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions

Wind scoured and bare on many aspects, Patchy and firm snow ice on others. Clear in the morning with poor visibility in clouds during afternoon. Calm conditions

Comments

Old snowpack will be bullet hard and icy, with serious consequences for any trips and slides from steep snow slopes onto boulders below. A cloudy day on the tops in prospect.
