

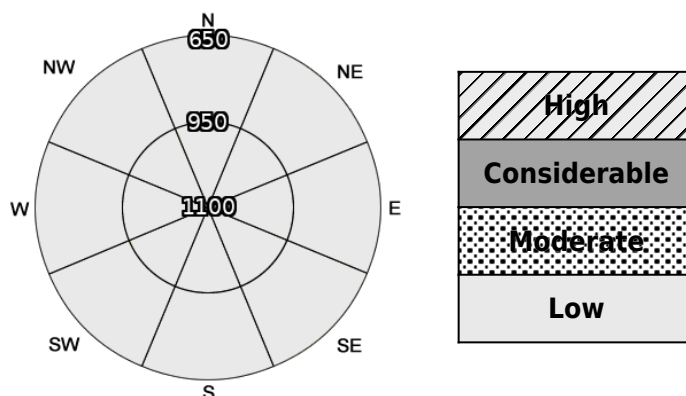

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 07/01/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some new snow instabilities will begin to develop above 800 metres, these on highest, very sheltered and mainly Easterly aspects. Quantities are not expected to achieve any significant depth during the forecast period. Elsewhere the very sparse snowpack will remain well stabilised. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Outbreaks of rain (some heavy) will develop overnight. During the day the Freezing level will lower to below summits and after midday any precipitation will start to fall as snow above 800 metres. The winds initially South- Westerly will be strong to gale force, West and then West North-West as the temperatures lower.
