

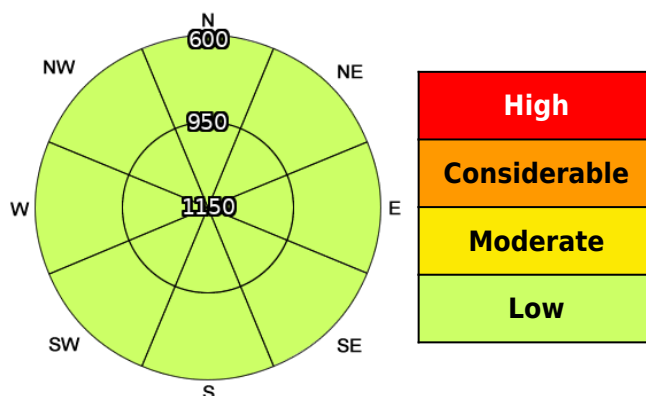

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 08/01/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snowfall will not be significant enough to alter the current conditions. The very patchy snow cover will remain firm and well bonded. Largest areas will be found on West through North to North-East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a dusting of snow above 700 metres overnight, dry thereafter. It will continue to be very windy from the North-North-West.

Comments

Becoming colder with the freezing level due to drop to around 600 metres by the end of the day. It will remain very windy.
