

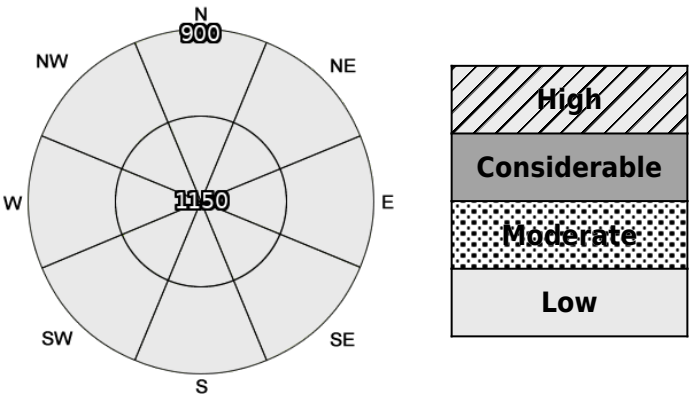

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 10/01/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. The patchy snowpack will generally be found above 900 metres and will remain well consolidated and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be mild and cloudy but generally dry. The freezing level will be around or just above the summits. Moderate winds will be from the West.
