

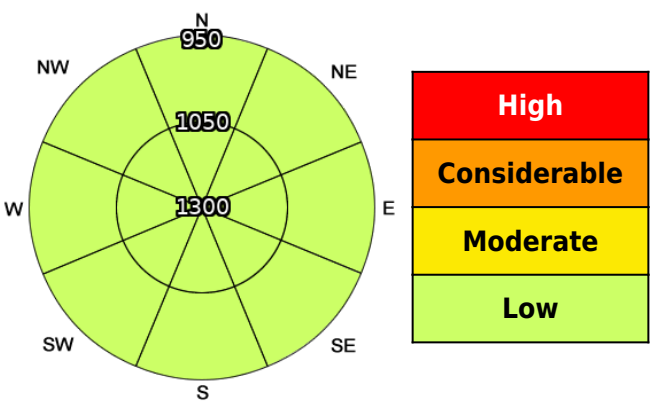

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 11/01/2019

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be no appreciable change in overall snowpack stability which remains good. Very small pockets of new windslab may develop on Easterly aspects above 1000 metres. These can be easily avoided. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain just above Munro level through the forecast period, starting to cool a little late Friday. There will be up to gale force Westerly winds over the tops with minimal precipitation in rain or snow showers over highest ground.

Comments

Most of the steep snow ice patches have a nasty rocky runout. Good crampon and axe technique required.
